



The name "Oliver" has been given to our groundhog in honor of Oliver Perry. Perry County was named after this successful Great Lakes American Naval Commander!



Clay Center of Ohio

resource and industrious people made Perry County home to many potteries and clay industries. In the early 1900s, the production of clay products employed more than 80% of the region's working population. Clay products are still manufactured in Crooksville, New Lexington, & Roseville and pottery is made by a small but growing number of local potters.

The Clay Center of Ohio, at 7327 Ceramic Rd. NE (this is at the southern most intersection of Ceramic Rd. NE and Ohio State Rt. 93 between Crooksville and Roseville), preserves the past and present practice of pottery making and clay products manufacturing.

There are frequent pottery making demonstrations, and new in 2019 will be hands-on participation with clay projects for children of all ages. Each year in July, an opening celebration and commemorative plate auction kick-off the Crooksville/Roseville Pottery Festival.

Exhibits illustrate the story of an array of clay products, including: functional stoneware, every day and decorative table ware, art pottery, architectural & paving brick, electric insulators, roof tiles, catalytic support media, kiln furniture, pizza stones & oven liners,

garden ware, ceramic drain tile, and even ceramic inserts for bullet proof vests – who knew?

A gift shop features pottery, ceramic and other arts & crafts.

The Clay Center of Ohio grounds include picnic sites and hiking trails. Wild turkeys, bluebirds, and all the region's woodpeckers may be seen.

Operating hours vary from May through October. A current schedule of hours and upcoming events is posted on the Facebook page "Clay Center of Ohio."


Mt. Perry Scenic Train (aka Zanesville & Western Scenic Railroad)


he Mt. Perry Scenic Train, which is also known as the Zanesville & Western Railroad, is located at 5700 St. Rt. 204 in Mt. Perry, Ohio. The Mt. Perry Scenic Train provides a scenic destination in southeastern Ohio, offering train excursions on an exceptionally scenic and historic rail line known as the Glass Rock Spur. Silica sand from Central Silica Company in Glenford was used in the manufacturing of glass, pottery, dinnerware and fire brick and was transported on the railroad as recently as 25 years ago. Over 100 years ago, during the time when coal was mined in many areas of southeastern Ohio, it was part of the Zanesville & Western Railroad, known to locals then as the "Zigzag & Wobbly."

The ZWSR offers train rides from July through the last weekend in October and a Santa Train in December. A roundtrip ride takes about 30-40 minutes.

Checkout our website www.zwsr.org for the schedule and ticket prices or the Facebook page Mt. Perry Scenic Train for numerous new special events planned in 2020. In addition, we're looking forward to the return of the Grassman Weekend in September, the Pumpkin Train in October, and the Santa Train in December.

The Scenic Railroad offers group rides for school or church groups, bus tours, and to host special events such as birthday parties, family outings, weddings and more. If you have questions about groups or special events, you can call 614-595-9701.

Januarius MacGahan Statue



anuarius Aloysius MacGahan was born in 1844 at Pigeon Roost near New Lexington and died in 1878 at the age of 33 in Constantinople. He is credited with the liberation of Bulgaria from Turkish domination because of the vivid and graphic dispatches he wrote for the London Daily News. It was due to his writings that England and Russia came to believe that the persecution of Bulgarians was a reality and rose to put an end to it.

His statue is located at the park on Main Street in New Lexington.

Nellie Sheridan Wilson Statue

he Nellie Sheridan Statue is located on the historic square in Somerset, Ohio and was dedicated September 29, 2018.

Nellie was born into a traditional Irish family but was not content to fill the usual role of a 19th century woman working only inside the home. Somerset's first female postmaster and one of the youngest in US history, Nellie at 19 sought the office and was first appointed by President Harrison in 1889 to serve until her retirement in 1930. Since postal regulations forbade married women from holding office, Nellie remained single despite having a longtime suitor Thomas C. Wilson, In 1913 Nellie finally married her ailing fiancé who died within hours of the wedding. Though heartbroken, she resumed her postmaster duties the following morning since there was no postal ruling against a widow holding the position.

She and her sister Mary were chiefly responsible for the creation and placement of their Uncle Phil Sheridan's equestrian bronze in Somerset square. She ran her own mercantile business (1914-1926) and benefitted the citizens of Perry County women in particular as a role model working in every civic and political enterprise. She was chairman of the Local American Red Cross during WWII, president of the Daughter of Union Veterans, secretary of Sheridan Monument Association and more, she earned a seat on the Republican



Executive Committee as well as the Ohio Committee for Improving Rural Government – truly a woman ahead of her time.

Phil Sheridan Statue

he Sheridan monument was erected by and given to the Village of Somerset by the State of Ohio in 1905 to honor the memory of Somerset's General Phillip Henry Sheridan. "Little Phil" was raised in Somerset and graduated from the United States Military Academy in 1852. He rendered valuable service to the Federal Army in the Civil War at Stone's River, Missionary Ridge, Yellow

Tavern, Winchester, Cedar Creek, Five Forks, and Appomattox. He later commanded in the West and became General of the Army in 1883, received his fourth star, and died in 1888. The heroic sculpture, created by Carl Heber of New York, portrays "Sheridan's Ride" to Winchester. Somerset citizens paid for the granite base through a children's "penny fund."



East off Rt. 13 onto Rt. 204, 8 miles to Gower Road. Turn south on Gower Road, then east onto Cooperrider Road. Bridge is ¼ mile down Cooperrider Road.

Jack's Hollow Bridge





The Old Gilmore Farm

Approximately ½ mile south of St. Rt. 13, three miles north of Somerset, on Reading Twp. Rd. 136 near the village of New Reading. Built in 1917 and rebuilt after a fire in 1932; now owned by Robert Meutzel.

The Old Mott Thomas Farm

On Jackson Twp. Road 94-A, within sight of St. Rt. 37, 1 mile east of Junction City.

Built in 1908; now owned by the John McGaughey family.

The Old Evi Melick Farm

On Madison Twp. Road 95, ½ mile north of US Rt. 22, 6 miles east of Somerset, near the village of Sego. Built in 1927; owned by Neil Cooperrider.



Shawnee Second Saturdays

n the summer of 2017 a group of residents from the southern Perry County Community of Shawnee began talking about hosting a monthly event on historic Main Street that would include an evening of music, food with vendors offering to sell their products.

Shortly after one of their meetings it was decided to move forward with a monthly scheduled event to be called Shawnee Second Saturdays. The volunteers of the group formed a non-profit, (501c3) organization called Destination Shawnee.

The goal of the committee is to not only provide a free evening of activities, but also introduce visitors to the Buckeye Trail, which is located on St. Rt. 93 at the edge of town, plus offer history tours by the village's historian Rob Dishon.

During the Second Saturdays, held April through October, vendors are welcome to set up (at no charge) and sell their products. In the event of rain activities and entertainment will be moved inside the Tecumseh Theater.

During the year Destination Shawnee will be hosting a variety of programs and concerts at the theater.

This spring Destination Shawnee

opened a First Friday Farmers Market from 5 to 7 p.m. on St. Rt. 93 (behind Main Street). The market is open from April through October. Local farmers and other vendors are welcome to set up at no charge. Destination Shawnee recently purchased five pop up tents and tables that are available for use during the market free of charge. These are available on a first come first serve basis.

Aside from the Second Saturday, which is held from 6 to 8 p.m., the group also hosts a Home Town Christmas event, which is set for Saturday, Dec. 7 starting at 6 p.m. at Saltlick Township Memorial Park on Main Street. Luminaries will line the street, plus there will be a local church choir performing followed by a program of music and refreshments at Tecumseh Theater, all free of charge.
